Sacramento County Code 9.80.010 Trespasses on Private Property Prohibited.

- a. No person shall remain upon any private property or business premises, after being notified by the owner or lessee or other person in charge thereof to remove therefrom.
- b. No person, without permission, express or implied, of the owner or lessee or other person in charge of private property or business premises, shall enter upon such private property or business premises after having been notified by the owner or lessee or other person in charge thereof to keep off or keep away therefrom.

California Penal Code Section 602(k)

Every person who willfully commits a trespass by any of the following acts is guilty of a misdemeanor:

(k) Entering any lands, whether unenclosed or enclosed by fence, for the purpose of injuring any property or property rights or with the intention of interfering with, obstructing, or injuring any lawful business or occupation carried on by the owner of the land, the owner's agent, or the person in lawful possession.
